Content of the conference

Digital transformation and sustainability are of great importance in the financial sector, as they are elsewhere in the social sciences and in the public debate. Despite some controversial discussions in these areas, there is still no conclusive definition of these terms in the financial industry and in society; in particular, their correlation to each other remains largely in the dark. The purpose of this conference is to present points of view on these topics and empirical findings on the issues involved. A concluding panel discussion on the opportunities and risks of digital currencies will focus the attention of the conference on a particularly topical issue, as it is of great relevance not only on a financial level, but also on a political and social level. The topic of "trust" will also be discussed, which is significant in the context of the reputation of currencies and their relevance as a globally accepted means of payment. The conference will be of interest to academics, practitioners, and the interested public with a connection to these topics.
